Requirements for being on BCM Leadership

- Must have been actively involved in BCM for at least a semester
- Must be involved in a local church
- Maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.70 in all courses
- Must be accountable to other leaders and the director
- Must attend at least 90% of worship times
- Must attend a planning retreat in August before school starts and a mid-year retreat in January.

Expectations for BCM Leadership members

- Pursue God daily in your own life - lead out in desiring personal spiritual growth
- Follow the leadership of Christ
- Pursue disciple-making on this campus as a top priority
- Expected to involve others in service
- Desire to set an example of Christ in all areas of life (public and private) - this includes abstaining from some activities, which may cause others to stumble and which result in you limiting your own personal freedoms.
- Attend all Leadership Team Meetings
- Expected to attend any retreats scheduled
- Give priority to BCM events
- Pursue excellence in everything we do
- Function as a HEALTHY team
- Be on TIME
- Handle conflicts quickly and BIBLICALLY
- Communicate with me and with others when needed
- Grow in your walk with the Lord
- Promote a unity of the Gospel with all ministries on this campus
- Refrain from the use of alcohol and tobacco products while serving on the BCM Leadership Team
